



Vashon Park District Volunteer Code of Ethics & Rules

1. Volunteers will portray a positive role model for youth by maintaining an attitude of respect, loyalty, patience, courtesy, tact, and maturity.
2. Volunteers should not expect benefits or favors from VPD in return for volunteering their time and talents.
3. Volunteers should be aware of the public perception that they are linked to Vashon Park District and should in no way act to discredit VPD.
4. Volunteers must treat children of all races, religions, and cultures with respect and consideration.
5. Volunteers must be free of physical and psychological conditions that might adversely affect children's health, including fever or contagious conditions.
6. Volunteers will do everything in their power to avoid being in a situation where they are alone with a child other than their own.
7. No alcohol.
8. No smoking.
9. No controlled substances.
10. No bullying, intimidation, or harassment.
